**To qualify for the program, you must be 60 years of age or older.**

**You must also be able to check at least ONE of these four boxes:**

- I receive SNAP benefits (food stamps), Medicaid, SSI, AFDC, welfare, or veterans aid;
- I participate in The Food Bank’s Brown Bag Program;
- I live alone and my income is below \$25,760; or,
- The total income of my household is below \$34,840 (only one share per household please).

**I understand:**

- That if I am selected as a participant of the Senior FarmShare program, I will receive a weekly share of fresh, local produce, and that the shares will vary in size and content depending on the time of the season.
- That there is no guarantee on the exact amount or type of produce I will receive in my share and that the farmer will supply a variety of fresh farm products.
- That if I do not pick up my share on any given week, it will be donated to a low-income person or emergency food shelter. If I am unable to pick up my share for an extended period of time, I will notify my distribution manager.
